Copyright and Publishing License:

- 1. **Creative Commons License:** All articles published in IJPOT are made available under the Creative Commons Attribution License (CC BY) version 4.0. This license allows users to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material for any purpose, even commercially, as long as appropriate credit is given to the original author(s) and the source is properly cited.
- 2. Author Retention of Rights: Authors retain the copyright to their work and grant the journal the right to publish their article under the terms of the CC BY 4.0 license.

Publication Costs:

1. Article Processing Charges (APCs): For Indian residents, the APC is Rs. 4000/-, and for non-Indians, it is USD 100. These charges cover the costs associated with the editorial process, peer review, publication, and archiving of articles. All articles are freely accessible to readers without any additional access fees.

Prepublication Consideration:

- 1. **Definition:** Prepublication refers to the prior availability of substantial portions of the manuscript in a manner that may compromise the originality or novelty of the work.
- 2. **Exclusions:** Manuscripts that have been previously published in substantially similar form, including preprints, conference proceedings, institutional repositories, or other public platforms, will not be considered for publication.

Plagiarism and Redundant/Overlapping Publication:

- 1. **Plagiarism:** Plagiarism, including the verbatim or near-verbatim copying of substantial portions of another's work without proper attribution, is strictly prohibited. Authors must ensure that their submissions are original and properly cite and attribute the work of others.
- 2. **Redundant/Overlapping Publication:** Submitting the same manuscript, or a substantially similar manuscript, to multiple journals simultaneously is considered redundant publication and is unethical. Authors must disclose any previous or concurrent submissions of the same work to other journals.
